

## Bicycles for Malawi

At the Request of our Partners in the Synod of Livingstonia, The Presbytery of Northern New York is helping to provide bicycles for Presbyterian ministers in Malawi.

Bicycles are necessary tools for minister in the Synod. This November a class of 14 new ministers will graduate from the Theological College at Ekwendeni. Each new minister will serve a church which will also have remote Preaching Points for those villagers who live far from the main church. Each minister needs a bicycle to travel the Preaching Points and to serve their parish.

We can fund each bicycle for about \$65. This is a wonderful opportunity for smaller congregations or perhaps a youth group to have a direct involvement in mission. The Rev. Levi Nyondo, General Secretary of the Synod of Livingstonia, promises a picture of each minister with their new bicycle.

Contributions to buy bicycles should be sent to the Presbytery of Northern New York, 8739 US Highway 11, Potsdam, NY 13676, marked "Malawi Bicycles.

If we've bought more than 14 bicycles, there are many other ministers in Malawi who could use a new ride. So think big.

When we've bought the bicycles, our presbytery has also been asked to fund a metal roof for a new church in the Synod of Livingstonia. . More information about this soon.
