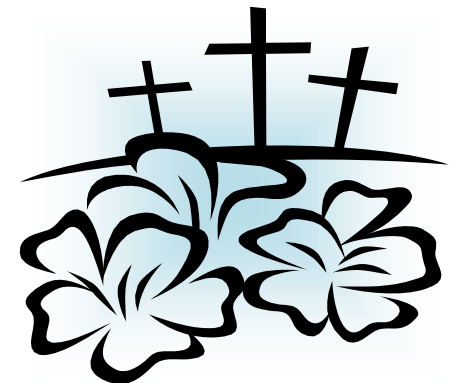
# TRAVEL DIRECTIONS AND LODGING

# OUR TIME TOGETHER

## PART 1

This part will focus on a basic boundaries awareness overview for ministers. In addition to providing an overview of sexual misconduct and harassment issues, it will cover many potential problems around maintaining ministerial boundaries.

## PART 2

Part 2 will wrestle with the question of “Why do boundaries not hold?” This section will explore from a variety of lenses, the underlying cause of boundary breakdown. These lenses include family systems theory, psychoanalytic theory, patriarchy, as well as theological issues. In addition, factors of depression, depletion, and burnout will be examined as contributing factors to boundary breakdowns. Some of the reasons around clergy burnout and depletion will be examined. Particular risk factors for misconduct will be examined in depth.

## PART 3

Finally, this workshop will examine the strategies for prevention of both burnout and boundary violations. Drawing on material from both parts 1 and 2, this section will explore preventive strategies aimed at avoiding potential boundary breakdown, as well as ministerial burnout.

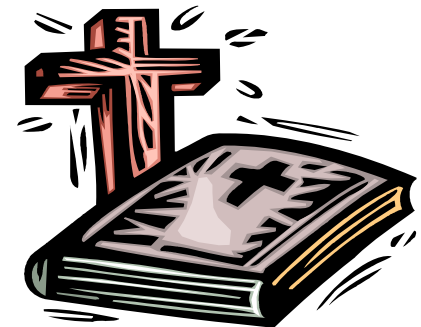
