Why a 1-Week Format?

Many pastors, church leaders, full time ministry staff and missionaries have found this schedule their most convenient option for taking PERSPECTIVES.

When?

- Registration and room check-in begins at 5 pm, Sunday August 15, with our first session beginning at 7 pm
- Classes run 8:30—11:00 am and 1:00 – 4:30 p.m. most days, with optional cross-cultural excursions in the evenings.
- We conclude Saturday evening with dinner. We encourage participants to make travel plans for Sunday, with the option of staying to worship together in Pittsburgh.

Cost?

- Basic registration is \$325, which includes the textbooks.
- Single room: \$50/night; Double room: \$70/night. Contact PTS Housing to make reservations, (412) 362-5610.
- Breakfast and lunch are available on campus, cost \$3-7/meal. Dinner at local ethnic restaurants with the class is an encouraged option (\$7-15).

How does the Leaders' Intensive version work?

- Classes are taught by a variety of dynamic speakers representing different backgrounds, education and experience, including pastors, missionaries, and professors.
- Lectures are complemented by discussions, activities, and opportunities to discern implications for local congregations.
- Certificate, Undergraduate, & Graduate study levels available.
- Required study through the first 5 lessons prior to the start of class.
- Completion of all readings, reviews & a projects is extended to November 15, 2010 for those who wish to complete the certificate level.
